HOW ANIME INFLUENCED THE WORLD

Comic Books, Films and Fan Meetings

Manga and *anime* were part of the Japanese pop culture long before they became popular in the USA and Europe. The word *manga* goes back to the late 18th century in Japan, but this type of comics didn't begin to be popular in the United States until the 1960s, when the famous Japanese *anime* series Astro Boy was imported to the U.S.

We are often asked the difference between *manga* and *anime*. They are both very important to Japanese culture, but the two are not the same thing. *Manga* is the name given to Japanese comic books and graphic novels and *anime* is the name given to Japanese animation (cartoon movies). The art style is important in *anime* films: cartoons generally have big eyes and great hairstyles.

Anime is a fantastic way to tell a story in animated form. However, in the last years, anime has become more than just animation films. More and more people around the world have become anime fans. Talking about anime, how can we forget *Pokemon*, those fine little pocket monsters? Nintendo's multi-billion-dollar *Pokemon* game was helped greatly by the anime series that, first on Japanese television in the late 1990s, is still on TV all over the world to this day. Thanks to *Pokemon*, anime has had a great influence on Western culture.

Imagination is a very important part of *anime*—everything is possible!—, and we can see that use of imagination has had its influence on many artists around the world from music, movies, and animation. The best films of the last years have taken ideas from *anime*. It has also influenced many famous people like actors and sports people. For example, film star Megan Fox loves Sailor Moon and she would like to be an actress in that series. Showman Hulk Hogan is a fan of *Pokemon* and he was seen playing a *Pokemon* game on a show.

Thanks to the Internet, you can watch *anime* free online 24/7 and with all the ideas from the new *anime* films, we will see more works influenced by this art form. Also, in the last years, fans have organized meetings all over the world. People normally go to these meetings to listen to experts and to meet *anime* artists. In these meetings, fans have started dressing like their favourite cartoons. So *anime* culture is not ending anytime soon.

QUEEN ELIZABETH II'S SECRET LETTER TO AUSTRALIA

The Queen's letter that can't be opened until 2085

Queen Elizabeth II, who died on September 8th 2022 at the age of 96, wrote a secret letter to
Australia, which is now[0] Sydney and can't be opened for 63 years! The letter, that
is kept safely, was written by the British Monarch in November, 1986. She [17] it to
the people of Sydney.
Nobody, including the Queen's personal staff, knows what the letter says [18] it is inside a glass case in a secret place. What we know is that it can't be opened until 2085.
The letter was sent to the Mayor of Sydney with this instruction: "On a day that you will

people of Sydney." It is ended simply: "Elizabeth R."
The Mayor said: "Queen Elizabeth II visited Australia 16 times. She was the[21]
