TRANSCRIPT

Today I'm sharing the top ten things to avoid doing when you visit Ireland. Here's my top ten things.

I. PACK A VARIETY OF CLOTHES

0. Don't underestimate the Irish weather. Ireland is famous for its ever-changing weather, and it's important to pack for all eventualities. G. KEEP LEFT

4. Don't drive on the wrong side of the road. If you're used to driving on the right side of the road, driving in Ireland can be a bit of a challenge. Keep in mind that they drive on the left side of the road and to make it easier for yourself, rent an automatic car.

J. SOMETHING NECESSARY FOR CHARGING BATTERIES

5. Don't forget to bring a plug adaptor. Ireland uses a different type of plug, so be sure to bring a plug adaptor for your electronics.

B. DON'T BE SURPRISED WITH COMMUNICATION PROBLEMS

6. Don't assume everyone speaks English. Although English is the official language of Ireland, some areas still use Irish Gaelic as their primary language. Don't be afraid to ask for help, but be respectful and patient if there's a language barrier.

L. TRY IT! IT'S BECOME MUCH BETTER!

7. Don't miss out on the incredible Irish cuisine. Irish food has come a long way in recent years with some incredible and unique dishes to try. Don't forget to try some traditional Irish stews, soda bread, fresh seafood and craft beer. Ask locals for recommendations and be adventurous in your food choices.

K. STUDY ITS PAST

8. Don't ignore the significance of Irish history. Ireland has a complex and fascinating history, and it's important to understand its significance when visiting. Don't ignore the historical context of the places you visit, and take the time to learn about Ireland's struggles for independence and the impact of colonialism.

E. HAVE A GOOD TIME

THE ROLLING STONES ANNOUNCE FIRST NEW ALBUM IN 18 YEARS

TRANSCRIPT

The Rolling Stones said this week that their first new collection of songs in almost 20 years comes out on **October 20th (0)**.

The album will be called **Hackney Diamonds (10)**. The name comes from broken glass often seen on the streets of east London's Hackney area.

Three of the band's original members - Mick Jagger, Keith Richards and Ronnie Wood – came to the Hackney Empire, **a historic theater (11)**, for the announcement.

The Rolling Stones are still traveling the world and performing concerts, but they have not made an album since 2016. That recording did not include new material.

Richards, 79, said **the band only made a new album because Jagger wanted to sing (12)**. So, they went to record new songs after almost 20 years.

"When you have a singer that wants to sing," Richards said, "you grab him and throw him in the studio."

They released the first song, called Angry, this week (13). But Jagger said the rest of the songs are not angry. He said the album contains "love songs, ballads, country..." sounds.

The new recording includes songs with Paul McCartney, Lady Gaga, Stevie Wonder and Charlie Watts, the Rolling Stones drummer who died in 2021. Watts recorded sounds for two songs in 2019. **Steve Jordan is the drummer for the other 10 (14)**. "Of course, he's missed incredibly," Richards said about Watts. But he added that Jordan was Watts' suggestion for a replacement.

Jagger said the addition of Lady Gaga to the album was unplanned. The Stones were recording at a studio in Los Angeles and Lady Gaga just happened to be in the studio next door. So, she recorded the song Sweet Sound of Heaven with the band.

"She walked in next to me and we started singing together (15)," Jagger said.

Wood said McCartney of the Beatles played the bass guitar on one track. "You know, he was loving it." **McCartney's band was perhaps the Rolling Stones' biggest rival in the 1960s (16)**.

The Rolling Stones started in 1962. **They celebrated their 60th year with a tour of Europe (17)** in 2022 and they said they have plans to visit North America in 2024.

Wood, 76, plays guitar. He said the idea of retirement is "Impossible. You've got to keep playing," he added. I'm Dan Friedell.

TRANSCRIPT

Mandela day takes place every year on the **18th of July (0)** and is named after the activist Nelson Mandela. The aim of Mandela Day is to encourage everyone to give a little bit of time to make a **positive (18)** impact on the lives of others. The day focuses on five main areas: **education (19)** and literacy, food and nutrition, shelter, sanitation and active citizenship.

Nelson Mandela lived in South Africa in the 1950s, when there was a lot of racial discrimination and division in the country called apartheid. Nelson Mandela believed everybody should have the **same rights (20)** and he fought very hard against discrimination. But he was imprisoned for his beliefs for **27 years (21)**. He was released from prison in 1990 and stood by his beliefs. He continued to fight for everyone's rights, and went on to win the Nobel Peace Prize in 1993 and become South Africa's first **black President (22)** in 1994.

Nelson Mandela is a very important person in history, and Mandela Day was started by the UN in **2009 (23)** as a way to honour his legacy. The best way to celebrate Mandela Day is by **helping others (24)**. You could donate clothes and books to those who need them. Volunteer at a food bank. Set up a **recycling station (25)** at home or at school. Pick up litter in your local park. There are so many ways you can help others and take part in Mandela Day.
